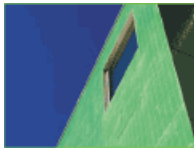

Scholefield to speak at construction re-building workshop

Pam Scholefield, the lead attorney for San Diego-based construction law firm **Scholefield Associates PC**, has volunteered to be a featured speaker at a local workshop to help contractors and fire victims survive the rebuilding process.
